2013 ANNUAL EMISSIONS REPORT

In the late part of December or in early January you probably received a letter from South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) requiring that your facility file an Annual Emissions Report (AER). The 2013 report, which includes operations in Calendar Year 2013 (January 1 through December 31), is due on Tuesday, March 4, 2014.

Facilities are required to report emissions of criteria pollutants and toxic air contaminants from both permitted and non-permitted sources. Associates Environmental staff has been preparing Annual Emissions Reports for more than 15 years and we are ready to assist you if you lack the time to deal with this report and the on-line submission process.

Certain facilities may also be required to report Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions to ARB and/or EPA. Please be aware that significant changes to California's Greenhouse Gas Mandatory Reporting Regulation became effective during 2012. Associates Environmental has ARB-accredited Greenhouse Gas Verifiers on staff to provide you with the most up to date information on how the federal and California GHG reporting regulations may impact your facility and your reporting requirements.

This year SCAQMD is beginning the transition to a new reporting program. This new program will require you to report emissions for individual pieces of equipment. Use of the new reporting program is voluntary this year, but will become mandatory next year.
