



## STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE WITH FLEET AVERAGE STANDARDS FOR THE PORTABLE ENGINE AIR TOXIC CONTROL MEASURE (ATCM) - DUE SOON!

The Portable Engine ATCM requires that a Statement of Compliance indicating that fleet average standards for particulate matter are being achieved be submitted by March 1, 2013 for the fleet standards that become effective January 1, 2013. A summary identifying each portable engine in the fleet and its emission rate must also be submitted. The Statement of Compliance and Fleet Summary should include all portable engines rated at 50 hp or greater that are either registered in the Portable Equipment Registration Program (PERP) **or permitted with a local air district**. Engines which are not subject to the Portable Engine ATCM (for example, crane auxiliary engines and marine engines) should not be included in the Statement of Compliance and Fleet Summary.

Now is the time to take a look at your fleet averages to determine whether you are in compliance with the January 1, 2013 fleet standards which appear below.

Fleet Standard Compliance Date	Engines < 175 hp (g/bhp-hr)	Engines 175 to 750 hp (g/bhp-hr)	Engines > 750 hp (g/bhp-hr)
January 1, 2013	0.3	0.15	0.25
