



## **\$3 Million in Carl Moyer Funding Available** San Diego Air Pollution Control District

The San Diego Air Pollution Control District (SDAPCD) has recently announced that they are accepting applications for projects requesting funds from the Carl Moyer Memorial Standards Attainment Program (Carl Moyer Program). Up to \$3 million is available to obtain voluntary emissions reductions through repowering or replacing older diesel engines with new diesel engines or equipment.

Funding is awarded on a first-come, first served basis to eligible applicants who submit complete applications. Funding tends to run out quickly and a few projects have already claimed nearly \$200,000 of the \$3 million available.
